DI PRO FLOATING LICENSE


A license that is shared among users based on concurrent usage. One administrator can manage and control all installations through a locally installed license server.

DI Pro license	DI Pro floating license
Non-personal (shareable)	Non-personal (shareable) (several concurrent users per license)
Installable on X machines per license	Licensed to X concurrent instances

CASE EXAMPLE:

A police force with 20 users but never more than 6 at one time. A license server is included in the delivery, and is installed locally. The license server allocates and keeps track of concurrent machines. This setup lets multiple users take advantage of the advanced features and capabilities of DI Pro but from a centrally administered and shared resource.

To make administration easy, one person is the licensor and administrator for all of the users thru the license server. This set-up is designed to work in a virtualized environment.
